 - Logistic service providers in operator role: ca. 30%







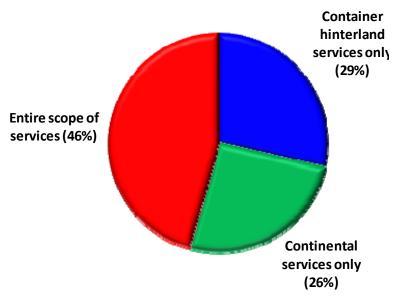

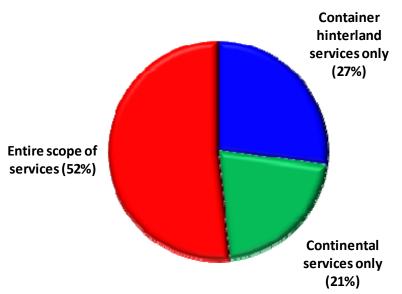


by number of companies per class

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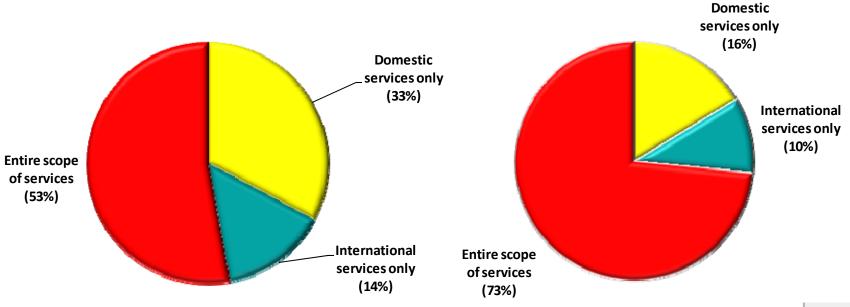




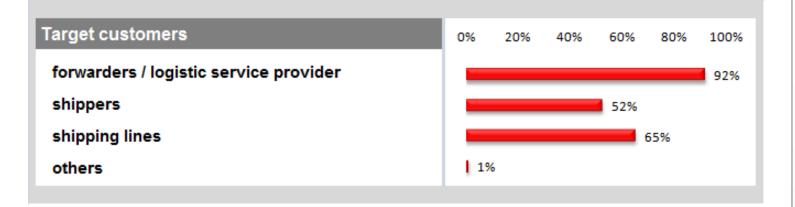

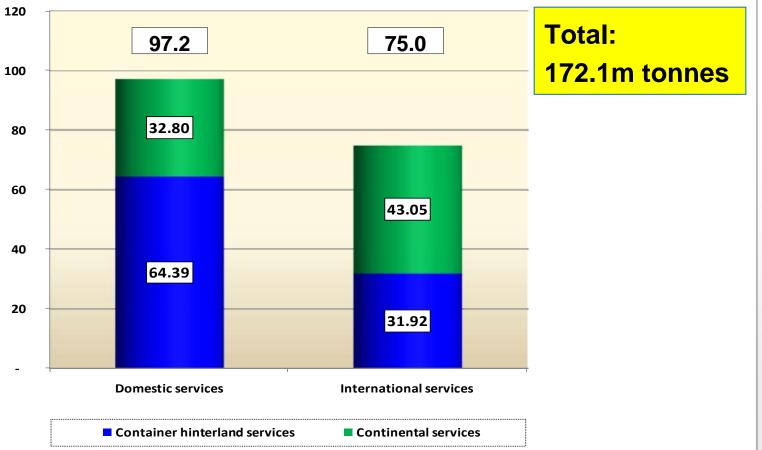


Unaccompanied intermodal traffic: goods shipped

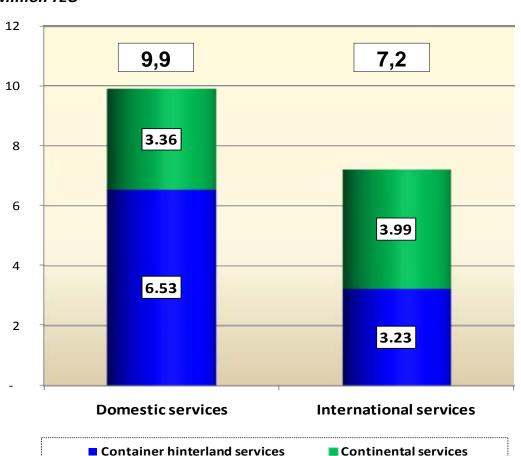


Unaccompanied intermodal traffic: TEU carried

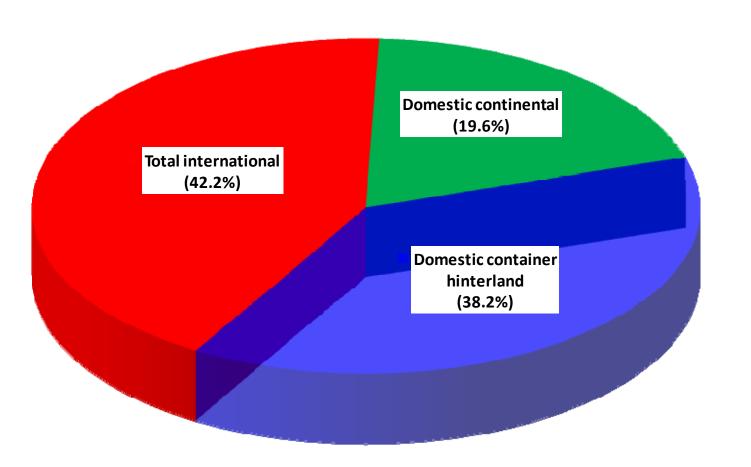

Domestic unaccompanied traffic by country 2007 (in TEU)





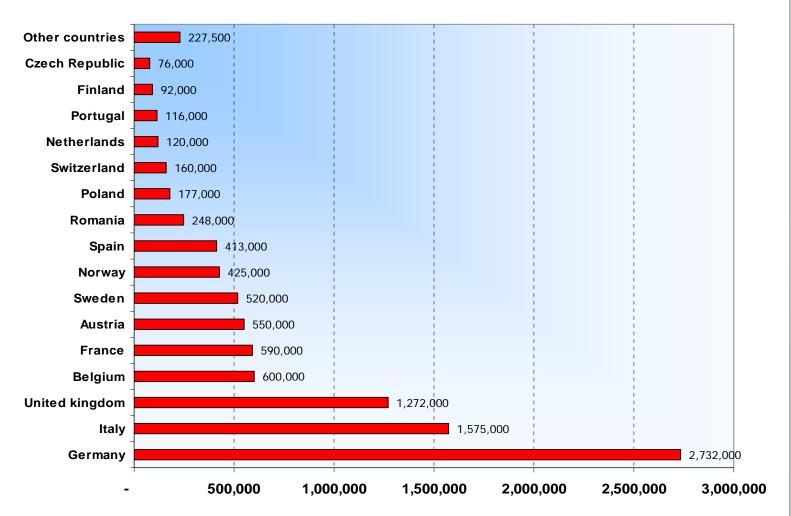

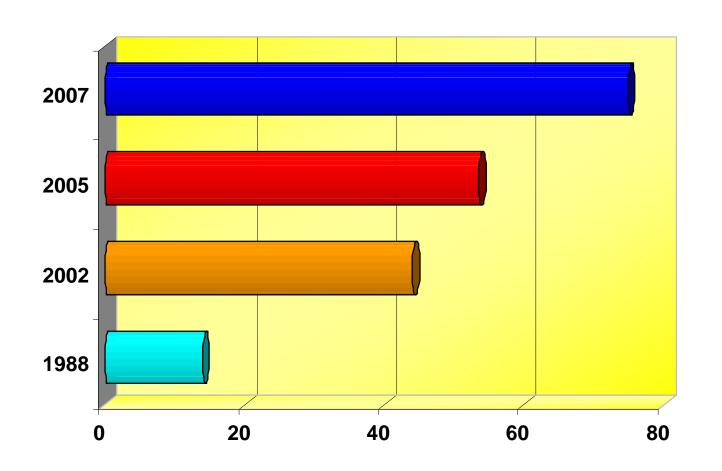




Unaccompanied international traffic 1988-2007 (in tonnes)

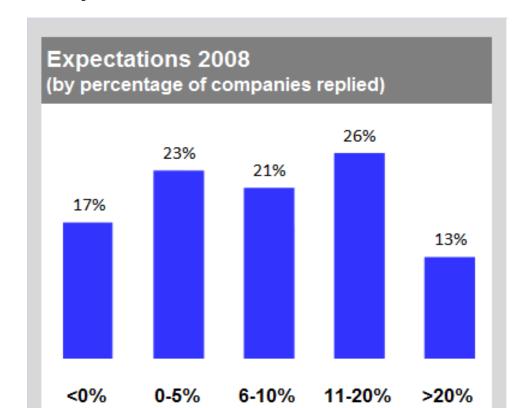








Expectations of intermodal service providers on unaccompanied traffic: 2008 vs 2007

2009/2008: + 11.7%

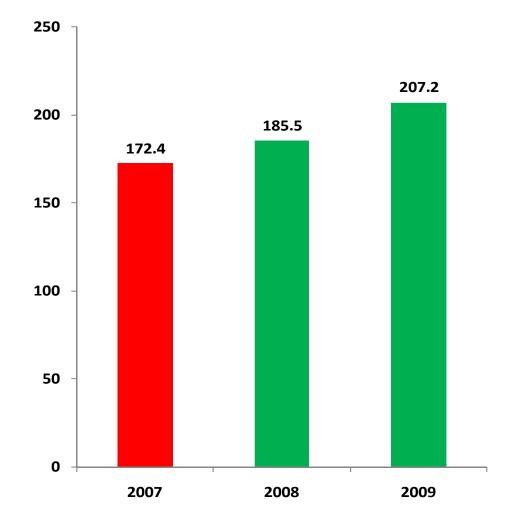
